6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the state-operated school system;  
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.08.020 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 14.08.020. GENERAL POWERS OF THE SYSTEM. There is  
11 created and established under the authority of art. III, sec. 22 of  
12 the Constitution of the State of Alaska a temporary state agency  
13 [A STATE CORPORATION] to be called the Alaska State-Operated School  
14 System. It may in that name

- 15 (1) sue and be sued;
- 16 (2) receive and hold real and personal property;
- 17 (3) contract and be contracted with;
- 18 (4) adopt, use and alter a corporate seal;
- 19 (5) adopt bylaws and administrative rules for the manage-  
20 ment and operation of the state-operated schools;
- 21 (6) accept grants or loans from and contract with the  
22 federal government, the state, or its political subdivisions, and  
23 to that end comply with the provisions of federal, state, or local  
24 programs when necessary;
- 25 (7) do and have done all matters necessary for the purpose  
26 of any function set out in this chapter.

27 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.08 is amended by adding a new section to read:

28 Sec. 14.08.155. LEGAL ASSISTANCE. The Department of Law shall  
29 provide all legal services for the board of directors.

1 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
2 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
