4 EIGHTH LEGISLATURE -- FIRST SESSION

5 Proposing accessibility to certain
6 state parks.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS state parks adjacent to large urban areas in the state are
9 specifically created so that the urban population can enjoy their scenic
10 beauty; and

11 WHEREAS the ready enjoyment of those things which the parks have to
12 offer is greatly dependent upon their accessibility to the general public;
13 and

14 WHEREAS there are existing service roads and trails in some of the state
15 parks which are closed to vehicular use by the general public; and

16 WHEREAS the opening of these service roads and trails to motor vehicle
17 traffic would go a long way toward making the parks accessible;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature respectfully requests the
19 Governor to direct the Department of Natural Resources to open existing
20 service roads and trails in state parks adjacent to urban areas and formulate
21 regulations as to their use so that the general public has improved access
22 to these state parks.
