HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 16
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
EIGHTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to the administration of
the Pupil Enrichment Resource Center
for Youth (PERCY).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, at present, the educational media development and reproduction program, Pupil Enrichment Resource Center for Youth, popularly known as "PERCY", is administered by the State-Operated School System; and

WHEREAS this invaluable educational program should be made available to all Alaska students not just those enrolled in State-Operated Schools;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska respectfully requests the Governor to direct the Department of Education and the State-Operated School System to conduct a joint feasibility study of the transfer of the administration of "PERCY" from the State-Operated Schools to the Department of Education, division of libraries, at the earliest possible date and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department and the State-Operated School System report their findings and recommendations to the Legislature not later than the 10th calendar day of the Eighth Legislature - Second Session.
