5 Relating to the highway between
6 Chugiak and Palmer.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS of all the roads in the state highway system, that portion of
9 the system between Chugiak and Palmer where the Anchorage-Palmer road con-
10 nects with the new Anchorage to Fairbanks highway is in a continual state
11 of disrepair; and

12 WHEREAS the highway between Chugiak and the Palmer area is one of the
13 most heavily traveled areas in the state; and

14 WHEREAS this stretch of road, due to its deteriorating condition, is
15 one of the most hazardous in the entire state; and

16 WHEREAS it is essential, both for the safety of the motoring public and
17 for the convenience of the public, that this portion of the state highway
18 system be repaired immediately and then be continuously maintained;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature that the Governor is respectfully
20 requested to direct the Department of Highways to make the necessary repairs
21 to that portion of the state highway system which lies between Chugiak and
22 Palmer and to continuously thereafter maintain the road in proper condition
23 for the safety of the public; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that the repairing and upgrading of the highway system
25 between Chugiak and Palmer be of the highest priority during the 1973 con-
26 struction season.
