5 Relating to National Engineers Week.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS the engineering profession will celebrate National Engineers
8 Week, February 18 - 24; and

9 WHEREAS engineering is the profession in which a knowledge of the mathe-
10 matical and physical sciences gained by study, experience and practice is
11 applied with judgment to develop ways to utilize economically the materials
12 and forces of nature for our progressive well-being; and

13 WHEREAS all people are aware of the important role of engineers in
14 creating, improving, and protecting the environment; and

15 WHEREAS it is of equal common knowledge that the engineering profession
16 has and continues to provide mankind with the facilities for community living,
17 industry, and transportation as well as aiding tremendously in the develop-
18 ment of structures for the utilization by all citizens of the world; and

19 WHEREAS the immediate years ahead will see yet further challenges to
20 the ingenuity and expertise of the technical community regarding innovations
21 required to protect and enhance our physical environment as well as meeting
22 our human needs;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature salutes and commends the
24 engineering profession and states its belief that the profession's focus for
25 the coming year, "A Better Environment through Technology," is indeed appro-
26 priate and reflects the same sensitivity that has characterized the profes-
27 sion in all of its past accomplishments and the Legislature affirms its faith
28 in the continued leadership and direction by the profession and its indivi-
29 dual members as a stronger and more vital society is ever pursued.
