5 Congratulating Jack Horton.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS it has been recently announced that Jack Horton has been  
8 nominated to the level of an Assistant Secretary of the Department of the  
9 Interior; and

10 WHEREAS Mr. Horton has long been associated with the Department of the  
11 Interior and has had an equally long association with Alaska; and

12 WHEREAS in 1969 he served as executive secretary of the federal task  
13 force on Alaskan oil development; and

14 WHEREAS he later served as a special assistant to former Secretary of  
15 the Interior Walter J. Hickel and eventually became a deputy undersecretary  
16 in 1971; and

17 WHEREAS he has most recently served Alaska as federal co-chairman of  
18 the Joint State-Federal Natural Resources and Land Use Planning Commission  
19 and in that role he played a key part in negotiating the out-of-court settle-  
20 ment between the state and federal governments which made possible initial  
21 federal set-asides under the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act; and

22 WHEREAS Alaska has been most fortunate to have had a man of Jack  
23 Horton's caliber connected with solving the problems of the state;

24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature that it expresses its thanks to Jack  
25 Horton for his past work in Alaska and for Alaskans and extends its heartiest  
26 congratulations and best wishes for every continued success in his new posi-  
27 tion.
