3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 EIGHTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to a study of the regulation  
6 of public transportation in Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS there has been introduced into both houses of the legislature  
9 a comprehensive new proposed transportation code for the state which would  
10 regulate all modes of transportation except transportation by pipeline; and

11 WHEREAS the proposed new code is extremely voluminous and marks, in  
12 many areas, a drastic departure from the state's current regulatory scheme;  
13 and

14 WHEREAS before enactment of such a comprehensive code the legislation  
15 ought to receive the closest scrutiny from the public at large and from the  
16 persons and groups of persons who would be vitally affected by enactment of  
17 the code; and

18 WHEREAS the complexity of the proposed legislation is such that it does  
19 not lend itself to the in-depth committee consideration called for during  
20 the course of a legislative session;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature that the Legislative Council is  
22 requested to make an in-depth study of the proposed legislation and all of  
23 its ramifications, such a study to include the holding of public hearings at  
24 appropriate places and with all interested groups and parties throughout the  
25 state; and be it

26 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council make its recommendations  
27 regarding enactment of the proposed new transportation code to the Eighth  
28 Legislature - Second Session.
