5 Relating to a study of proposed
6 state antitrust legislation.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS there is legislation pending before the legislature that, if
9 enacted, would establish antitrust provisions in state law; and

10 WHEREAS this legislation would be in addition to the voluminous federal
11 antitrust acts; and

12 WHEREAS the proposed legislation embodies concepts contained in the
13 Sherman, Clayton, and Federal Trade Commission Acts, as well as seeking to
14 formalize developments in case law; and

15 WHEREAS this proposed legislation is of a complex nature and its enact-
16 ment would affect the commerce and trade of Alaska; and

17 WHEREAS persons are in disagreement over the need of, the effect of,
18 and the full ramifications possible if the proposed legislation were enacted;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature that the Legislative Council is
20 directed to undertake an interim study of the necessity, meaning, and all
21 ramifications of the proposed legislation, such interim study to include
22 the holding of public hearings if considered necessary by the Council; and
23 be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council's recommendation regarding passage
25 of this proposed state antitrust legislation be given to the Eighth Legisla-
26 ture - Second Session.
