5 Relating to the administration of the
6 Pupil Enrichment Resource Center for
7 Youth (PERCY).

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS, at present, the educational media development and reproduction
10 program, Pupil Enrichment Resource Center for Youth, popularly known as
11 "PERCY", is administered by the State-Operated School System; and

12 WHEREAS this invaluable educational program should be made available to
13 all Alaska students, not just those enrolled in State-Operated Schools;

14 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
15 the Governor to direct the Department of Education and the State-Operated
16 School System to conduct a joint feasibility study of the transfer of the
17 administration of "PERCY" from the State-Operated Schools to the Department
18 of Education, division of libraries, at the earliest possible date; and be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department and the State-Operated School System
20 report their findings and recommendations to the Legislature not later than
21 the 10th calendar day of the Ninth Legislature - First Session.
