Honoring Mr. Edward W. Allen.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Mr. Edward W. Allen, the "Grand Old Man" of the North Pacific

Fisheries, has been forced into early retirement by an unrelenting "sawbones"

WHEREAS his active participation since 1932 in all phases of the North

Pacific Fisheries indicates just a bit more than the average dedication that

a single man can show for a given cause; and

WHEREAS during these all too short years of service he has been an

inspiration to his fellow members of the many commissions on which he has

served, albeit as a "dutch uncle" on occasion; and

WHEREAS phrases such as "wise use of renewable resources" and "conserva-

tion management of resources" were concepts in Mr. Allen's mind and used as

18

deep-water channel markers 50 years before they were put together as popular

expressions; and

WHEREAS through patience, tempered by resolve, Mr. Allen has not only

helped to instill these concepts in the minds of his fellow countrymen but

22

has carried them abroad with equal effectiveness; and

WHEREAS the above enumerated corner posts are only illustrative of the

huge superstructure which Mr. Allen has erected for those who follow him to

build upon;

Alaska, as one of Mr. Allen's many beneficiaries, extends its warmest thanks

for the outstanding job he has done to date, with the hope that his guidance
