9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS throughout the years tourism clearly has been one of Alaska's  
11 largest, most profitable and stable industries; and

12 WHEREAS it is evident that travel to Alaska will only continue to  
13 expand as transportation systems and services improve whether by land, sea  
14 or air and interest in the uniqueness and magnificence of Alaska increases;  
15 and

16 WHEREAS Anchorage is the hub of highway and rail traffic, as well as  
17 both domestic and international flights; and

18 WHEREAS a fundamental requisite for a sound tourism program is the  
19 availability of adequate, if not superior, information services, personnel  
20 and facilities -- clearly lacking at present in Anchorage.

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature respectfully requests the  
22 Governor to direct the Commissioner of Economic Development to request ade-  
23 quate funds for the placement of an information specialist from the Alaska  
24 Travel Division in Anchorage.

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
