5 Relating to the pending trial of

6 Charles Bundrant.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the State of Alaska has filed criminal charges against one  
9 Charles Bundrant, Captain of a "mobile processor" vessel; and

10 WHEREAS it is alleged that the ship's cargo consisted mainly of under-  
11 sized crab and that the alleged offense took place during a closed season  
12 and in closed waters; and

13 WHEREAS this case is a perfect illustration of the ever-increasing  
14 problem that Alaska is experiencing with "mobile processor" ships; and

15 WHEREAS, if the State's allegations are found to be true, Captain  
16 Bundrant's ship is said to have had on board crab equal to a value of  
17 \$3,000,000 wholesale; and

18 WHEREAS this pending case is extremely significant because of the many  
19 illegal activities charged and points up the type of violations that occur  
20 almost daily;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is  
22 respectfully requested to direct the Attorney General to keep all members of  
23 the Legislature informed as to all developments regarding this pending  
24 action.
