5 Urging the formation of a rural
6 housing assistance committee for the
7 purpose of disseminating necessary
8 housing information.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS, as a result of the current freeze of public housing funds, it
11 is difficult for those persons and organizations most in need to acquire
12 information regarding available financing and housing programs; and

13 WHEREAS it is well-recognized that centralized data accumulation and
14 uniform dissemination of information would do much to facilitate increased
15 exposure to housing programs and other assistance which may be available; and

16 WHEREAS persistent and aggressive efforts like that of the Tlingit-Haida
17 Housing Authority in procuring 200 units of low-cost single-family dwellings,
18 notwithstanding the freeze on U. S. Housing and Urban Development funds,
19 should be analyzed and evaluated by a central committee so that those proce-
20 dures and techniques can be recommended for other persons and housing
21 authorities;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is
23 respectfully requested to appoint a special rural housing assistance commit-
24 tee to operate independently but within the Department of Community and
25 Regional Affairs, which would have the purpose of analyzing and disseminating
26 available housing assistance program information to interested persons,
27 organizations and housing authorities.

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
