2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 58

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 EIGHTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the construction of a
6 rifle range by the Alaska National
7 Guard.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Sitka National Guard unit is in need of an adquate firing
10 range to properly conduct their weapons qualification training; and

11 WHEREAS a firing range could be utilized by all citizens in the com-
12 munity as is the range in Juneau, which was constructed by the National
13 Guard unit there; and

14 WHEREAS, at the present time the 910th Combat Engineering Company,
15 stationed at Juneau, is scheduled to go to Fort Richardson in the spring
16 of 1974 for a minor construction project which involves moving numerous
17 heavy construction vehicles over the Alaska Highway, consuming not only
18 valuable time but huge amounts of fuel; and

19 WHEREAS there is adequate time to reschedule the annual two week
20 training period, so that this needed project can be constructed at Sitka; and

21 WHEREAS the citizen soldier concept can best be exemplified by
22 community betterment training programs of this nature;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct
24 the Adjutant General to reschedule the training duty for the 910th Combat
25 Engineer Company so that a firing range may be constructed at Sitka during
26 its 1974 duty assignment.
