8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS Alaska Indian Arts, Inc. has been in existence since 1957; and

10 WHEREAS Alaska Indian Arts was organized to promote the restoration
11 and revival of Alaska's Indian arts, crafts, and culture; and

12 WHEREAS Carl Heinmiller and the Alaska Council on the Arts have been
13 instrumental in assuring the success of this program; and

14 WHEREAS since 1957 Alaska arts and crafts and Indian culture have
15 been promoted worldwide and exhibits shown at numerous places, including
16 the world's fair in Japan and the Sealaska show and an exhibit has been
17 prepared for Expo '74; and

18 WHEREAS, in addition to all of the above, the program has been a source
19 of employment for many young Alaskans and many handicapped Alaskans;

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it commends Carl
21 Heinmiller, the Alaska Council on the Arts, and Alaska Indian Arts, Inc.
22 for their proven devotion to the preservation and restoration of Alaska's
23 Indian arts and crafts and culture and urges the continuation of these many
24 successful and valuable pursuits.
