3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 EIGHTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the development of an
6 aquatic resources curriculum by
7 the University of Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the renewable aquatic resources of Alaska must be pursued,
10 enhanced and properly harvested for the wise utilization of these resources;
11 and

12 WHEREAS the University of Alaska is currently lacking in the develop-
13 ment of viable instructional programs geared to the training of professional
14 fishery resource personnel and technicians; and

15 WHEREAS many areas of the state, including communities such as
16 Juneau, Kodiak, and Seward, would be ideal locations for the establishment
17 of these programs; and

18 WHEREAS proper course instruction could be accomplished through the
19 offering of instructional courses at the appropriate campuses as well as
20 through the extension centers of the University of Alaska's statewide
21 system;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the University
23 of Alaska is respectfully requested to immediately undertake the develop-
24 ment of instructional programs concerning Alaska's aquatic resources for
25 utilization at sites suitable to such studies throughout the state; and
26 be it

27 FURTHER RESOLVED that the University is requested to furnish the
28 Ninth Legislature - First Session with its requests outlining in detail
29 the programs and recommendations developed in response to this resolution.
