5 Relating to the Iditarod Trail Race.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS the Iditarod Trail Race stretches over 1,000 miles of this great
8 state; and

9 WHEREAS the race begins in Anchorage and passes through Knik, Susitna
10 Station, Skentna Finger Lake, Rainy Pass, Rohn Road House, Farewell Lake,
11 Salmon River, McGrath, Ophir, Bear Creek, Ruby, Galena, Koyukuk, Nulato,
12 Kaltag, Old Woman, Unalakleet, Shaktoolik, Koyuk, Elim, Golovin, White
13 Mountain, Solomon, ending in Nome; and

14 WHEREAS the race provides excitement and pleasure to great numbers of
15 Alaskans and tests the participants to the nth degree; and

16 WHEREAS the occasion of the race involves many Alaskans and offers
17 persons all over the state the opportunity to become acquainted with dog
18 mushing - the state sport; and

19 WHEREAS the race, now in its second year of existence, is planned as an
20 annual event from now on;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is
22 respectfully requested to give official state sanction to the race and to
23 take all steps necessary to have the Iditarod Trail Race designated as the
24 official state race.
