5 Honoring Earl Hoggard.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS, on March 30, patrolman Earl Hoggard of the Ketchikan City
8 Police was fatally wounded in the line of duty; and

9 WHEREAS patrolman Hoggard was slain only two days before his first
10 anniversary with the department; and

11 WHEREAS, a Ketchikan resident for sixteen years, he previously had
12 served his country in the United States Coast Guard for twenty years; and

13 WHEREAS he was also active in community, fraternal, and professional
14 organizations; and

15 WHEREAS without devoted and courageous men such as Earl Hoggard who
16 are willing to lay their lives on the line on a day-to-day basis, citizens
17 could never be secure in their own well-being and in their possession of
18 goods;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it expresses its
20 most heartfelt sorrow at the untimely passing of Earl Hoggard, but at the
21 same time is certain that Earl Hoggard will be long remembered by his fellow
22 Alaskans, and especially by his fellow officers, as one of those rare true-
23 to-life persons who paid the supreme penalty because he believed in his job
24 and the heavy responsibilities of that job.
