8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS Mrs. Mable R. Rasmussen has made of motherhood more than just
10 an incident, indeed a lifetime occupation; and

11 WHEREAS Mrs. Rasmussen and her husband, Harry, founded Hospitality House,
12 a home for girls in Fairbanks, Alaska in 1957; and

13 WHEREAS she served with distinction as Administrator of Hospitality House
14 until her retirement in 1973; and

15 WHEREAS during those 16 years Mrs. Rasmussen provided a mother's love
16 and concern to hundreds of girls from every corner of Alaska; and

17 WHEREAS many of these girls are now mothers with a better chance of
18 successfully raising their own children due to the guidance provided over the
19 years by "Ma" Rasmussen; and

20 WHEREAS Mable Rasmussen has served as President of the Alaska Association
21 of Child Caring Institutions for four years and was involved in drawing up
22 standards of child care for Alaska; and

23 WHEREAS she has been active in setting up many programs for youth,
24 particularly Native youth, and, in fact, has been made an honorary member of
25 the Fairbanks Native Association;

26 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it joins all Alaskans
27 in commending Mable R. Rasmussen upon her accomplishments and congratulates
28 her upon her selection as Alaskan Mother of the Year 1974.
