2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 EIGHTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Proposing that the Constitution of the  
6 State of Alaska be amended to reduce  
7 the residency requirements for election  
8 to the legislature.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. Sec. 2, art. II, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is  
11 repealed and re-enacted to read:

12 SECTION 2. MEMBERS' QUALIFICATIONS. A member of the legislature  
13 shall be a qualified voter who, immediately preceding filing for office,  
14 has been both a resident of Alaska for at least one year and a member  
15 of the district from which elected for at least 90 days. A senator  
16 shall be at least twenty-five years of age and a representative at  
17 least twenty-one years of age.

18 \* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed  
19 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity  
20 with sec. 1, art. XIII, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election  
21 laws of the state.
