5 Expressing gratitude to President

6 Richard M. Nixon.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the everyday affairs of all citizens of the United States have  
9 been overshadowed and plagued for many long years by the Vietnam conflict;  
10 and

11 WHEREAS the single overriding concern of our last three presidents and  
12 the energies of the executive office have, of necessity, been oriented toward  
13 the conflict in Southeast Asia; and

14 WHEREAS, throughout these many years, this conflict has occasioned  
15 heated debate among our leaders and divided the American people as no other  
16 recent issue in United States history; and

17 WHEREAS all Americans have greeted with the deepest relief and gratitude  
18 the announcement that the South Vietnam conflict has finally been terminated;  
19 and

20 WHEREAS the Alaska Legislature mourns the loss of the thousands of dead  
21 and expresses its deep regret and sympathy for the wounded and missing in  
22 action and for the families and relatives of those dead, wounded and missing  
23 in action;

24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that this Resolution serve as  
25 an expression of our most profound gratitude to President Richard M. Nixon  
26 for having attained, on behalf of the United States of America and all of  
27 its citizens, as well as our allies, a cease fire.
