5 Proposing an amendment to the amend-
6 ment and revision section of the
7 Constitution of the State of Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Section 1, art. XIII of the Constitution of the State of
10 Alaska is amended to read:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS. Amendments to this constitution may be
12 proposed by a two-thirds vote of each house of the legislature. The
13 lieutenant governor shall prepare a ballot title and proposition sum-
14 marizing each proposed amendment, and shall place them on the ballot
15 for the next general [STATEWIDE] election. If a majority of the votes
16 cast on the proposition favor the amendment, it shall be adopted.
17 Unless otherwise provided in the amendment, it becomes effective thirty
18 days after the certification of the election returns by the lieutenant
19 governor.

20 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before
21 the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity with
22 sec. 1, art. XIII of the Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the state
23 election laws.
