5 Proposing an amendment to the amend-
6 ment and revision section of the
7 Constitution of the State of Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Section 1, art. XIII of the Constitution of the State of
10 Alaska is amended to read:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS. Amendments to this constitution may be
12 proposed by a two-thirds vote of each house of the legislature. The
13 lieutenant governor shall prepare a ballot title and proposition sum-
14 marizing each proposed amendment, and shall place them on the ballot
15 for the next general [STATEWIDE] election or special election if the
16 special election is held more than six months after the amendment or
17 amendments have been proposed by the legislature. If a majority of
18 the votes cast on the proposition favor the amendment, it shall be
19 adopted. Unless otherwise provided in the amendment, it becomes
20 effective thirty days after the certification of the election returns
21 by the lieutenant governor.

22 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before
23 the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity with
24 sec. 1, art. XIII of the Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the state
25 election laws.
