5 Proposing an amendment to the state
6 constitution regarding legislative
7 sessions.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Section 10, art. II of the Constitution of the State of
10 Alaska is amended to read:

11 SECTION 10. ADJOURNMENT. Neither house may adjourn or recess for
12 longer than three days unless the other concurs except that either
13 house after being in session 90 days or longer may by a majority vote
14 of either house adjourn the legislature subject to being called
15 immediately back into special session by the governor. If the two
16 houses cannot agree on the time of adjournment and either house certi-
17 fies the disagreement to the governor, he may adjourn the legislature.

18 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed
19 before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity
20 with sec. 1, art. XIII, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the state
21 election laws.
