5 Proposing amendments to the Consti-
6 tution of the State of Alaska relating
7 to the age qualifications for the
8 governor and members of the legis-
9 lature.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. Art. II, sec. 2, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is
12 amended to read:

13 SECTION 2. MEMBER'S QUALIFICATIONS. A member of the legislature
14 shall be a qualified voter who has been a resident of Alaska for at
15 least three years and of the district from which elected for at least
16 one year, immediately preceding his filing for office. [A SENATOR SHALL
17 BE AT LEAST TWENTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE AND A REPRESENTATIVE AT LEAST
18 TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE.]

19 * Sec. 2. Art. III, sec. 2, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is
20 amended to read:

21 SECTION 2. GOVERNOR'S QUALIFICATIONS. The governor shall be [AT
22 LEAST THIRTY YEARS OF AGE AND] a qualified voter of the State. He shall
23 have been a resident of Alaska at least seven years immediately pre-
24 ceding his filing for office, and he shall have been a citizen of the
25 United States for at least seven years.

26 * Sec. 3. The amendments proposed by this resolution shall be placed
27 before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity
28 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election
29 laws of the state.
