2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 57

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 EIGHTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to federal grants and similar  
6 programs.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS federal grants and similar programs which develop or strengthen  
9 any part of the nation ultimately contribute to the vitality and integrity of  
10 the nation as a whole; and

11 WHEREAS, to serve their intended purposes, they must meet the demands  
12 of the location where they are to be applied; and

13 WHEREAS in states with special problems of vast area coupled with low  
14 population, high wages, and high costs, there are often, as in Alaska,  
15 correspondingly special benefits to be reaped from successful programs;

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Congress of the  
17 United States and the national administration are respectfully urged to give  
18 the special consideration reasonably demanded by these special problems when  
19 funding and administering grants and other programs.

20 COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Richard M. Nixon,  
21 President of the United States; the Honorable James Eastland, President  
22 Pro Tempore of the Senate; The Honorable Carl Albert, Speaker of the House;  
23 and to the Honorable Ted Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S.  
24 Senators, and the Honorable Donald E. Young, U. S. Representative, members  
25 of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
