2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 60

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 EIGHTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to legislation requiring
6 federal subdivisions to conform to
7 local subdivision standards and
8 regulations.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS building requirements in Alaska are extraordinary and often
11 exceed those for a less demanding area; and

12 WHEREAS there has been ample evidence of the need for improvement in
13 the construction of federal subdivisions in Alaska, notably at Bethel and
14 Anchorage; and

15 WHEREAS to ignore these requirements results in needless hardship on
16 the occupants as well as costly and awkward attempts to repair deficiencies
17 at a later date; and

18 WHEREAS to acknowledge local experience in construction would improve
19 long-run economy and performance;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Congress of the United States is respectfully
21 requested to enact legislation requiring any federal subdivisions to conform
22 to local subdivision standards and regulations where those local standards
23 and regulations impose more restrictive requirements.
