6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to tax and fee relief for senior
7 citizens; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 43.20.020(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to
10 read:

11 (4) the first \$3,750 of income if the taxpayer has attained
12 the age of 65 before the close of his taxable year; an additional
13 exemption of \$3,750 of income is allowed for the spouse of the taxpayer
14 if the spouse has attained the age of 62 before the close of the tax-
15 able year; the exemption provided is cumulative and is not intended to
16 replace existing exemptions; the exemption may be allowed only in the
17 proportion that the number of months the taxpayer is physically present
18 in the state bears to 12 months.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 43.45.020 is amended to read:

20 Sec. 43.45.020. PERSONS EXEMPT FROM TAX. Persons in the active
21 military or naval service of the United States, persons 65 years of age
22 or older, paupers, insane persons, persons cared for by the state and
23 persons permanently injured, infirm, maimed or crippled so as to be
24 disabled from earning a livelihood are exempt from the payment of the
25 school tax.

26 * Sec. 3. AS 28.10.200(b)(2) is amended to read:

27 (2) except as provided in (b)(7), (b)(8), [AND] (b)(9) and
28 (b)(11) of this section, for a motor vehicle not designed, used, or
29 maintained primarily for the transportation of passengers or property

2 * Sec. 4. AS 28.10.200(b) is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

3 (11) for a motor vehicle (including a pickup truck which does
4 not exceed 6,000 pounds, unladen weight) not designed, used, or main-
5 tained primarily for the transportation of passengers or property for
6 hire owned and principally operated by a resident 65 years of age or
7 older, \$5.

8 * Sec. 5. AS 16.05.340(a)(1) is amended to read:

9 (1) Resident sport fishing license [. \$ 5]
10 (A) [HOWEVER, THE FEE IS \$1] for a resident who is
11 blind or 65 years of age or older \$ 1
12 (B) for all other residents 5

13 * Sec. 6. AS 16.05.340(a)(2) is amended to read:

14 (2) Resident hunting license
15 (A) for a resident 65 years of age or older . . \$ 1
16 (B) for all other residents 7

17 * Sec. 7. AS 16.05.340(a)(4) is amended to read:

18 (4) Resident hunting and sport fishing license
19 (A) for a resident 65 years of age or older . . . \$ 2
20 (B) for all other residents 12

21 * Sec. 8. AS 16.05.340(a)(5) is amended to read:

22 (5) Resident hunting, trapping, and sport fishing
23 license [. 15]
24 (A) [HOWEVER, THE FEE IS 25 CENTS] for the head of
25 a family or a dependent member of his family or one solely
26 dependent upon himself for support, upon proof presented by the
27 applicant that he [THE APPLICANT (A)] is obtaining or has obtained
28 assistance during the preceding six months under any state or
29 federal welfare program [TO AID THE INDIGENT] , or [(B)] has an

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annual family gross income of less than \$3,600 for the year
preceding application \$.25
(B) for a resident 65 years of age or older . . . 3.00
(C) for all other residents 15.00
