6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to burial of body."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 12.65.100 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 12.65.100. BURIAL OF BODY. When a coroner holds an inquest
10 upon a body, [THE BODY OF A STRANGER OR PAUPER] and no friend or
11 relative appears to claim the body for burial, and no provision is made
12 for the body under AS 13.50, the coroner shall notify the Department of
13 Health and Social Services which shall cause the body to be plainly
14 and decently buried or cremated and the remains decently interred.
