6 For an Act entitled: "An Act repealing legislative per diem; fixing legis-
7 lative compensation; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 24.15.010 is repealed.

11 * Sec. 2. AS 24.15.020 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 24.15.020. ANNUAL LEGISLATIVE SALARIES. The annual salary
13 for each member of the legislature is \$12,500 [\$9,000] to be paid in
14 approximately equal monthly payments. The annual salary includes a
15 payment for subsistence or per diem in lieu of subsistence. The presi-
16 dent of the senate and speaker of the house of representatives are
17 each entitled to an additional \$500 a year during tenure of office.

18 * Sec. 3. AS 24.15.040 is amended to read:

19 Sec. 24.15.040. METHOD OF PAYMENT. Salaries [, PER DIEM] and
20 additional allowances for members of the legislature shall be paid by
21 warrants drawn on vouchers approved by the legislative fiscal officer.

22 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect January 1, 1974.
