6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to guiding."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 16.50 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9       Sec. 16.50.147. RESTRICTION TO DISTRICT. No guide licensed under  
10 secs. 115 - 135 of this chapter shall engage in guiding activities in  
11 any manner, including but not limited to contracting for hunts, em-  
12 ploying assistant guides, furnishing camps, and providing equipment and  
13 supplies, in a district for which he is not certified. No guide may be  
14 certified for more than one guide district per calendar year. A guide  
15 licensed under secs. 115 - 135 of this chapter who wishes to engage in  
16 guiding activities in a district other than the one for which he is  
17 originally certified, shall apply for certification for the different  
18 district in the same manner as he applied originally. Nothing in this  
19 section limits a guide licensed under secs. 115 - 135 of this chapter  
20 from guiding in more than one district for the purpose of photography  
21 only.

22 \* Sec. 2. A guide licensed under AS 16.50.115 - 16.50.135 as of the ef-  
23 fective date of this Act, who is certified for more than one district,  
24 unless he is guiding for the purpose of photography only, shall, within 60  
25 days of the effective date of this Act, choose one district in which he in-  
26 tends to engage in guiding activities initially, and he is subsequently  
27 limited to guiding in that district for the remainder of the calendar year  
28 in which this Act takes effect. If he wishes to be certified for a different  
29 district in a subsequent calendar year, he shall apply for certification for

1 the different district in the same manner as he applied originally. The  
2 certification of a guide licensed under AS 16.50.115 - 16.50.135 who fails to  
3 make his selection within the specified time, terminates without refund of  
4 the initial fee.

5 \* Sec. 3. A guide licensed under AS 16.50.115 - 16.50.135 as of the  
6 effective date of this Act, who has entered into a contract before the ef-  
7 fective date of this Act for the purpose of guiding a client in a district  
8 other than the one in which he intends to engage in guiding activities  
9 initially, as required by this Act, shall present to the department proof of  
10 the contract. Upon submission of satisfactory proof of a prior contract,  
11 the department shall issue an extension to the guide to permit performance  
12 of that contract only.
