6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to guiding."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 08.54 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 08.54.155. RESTRICTION TO DISTRICT. (a) No guide licensed
10 under secs. 100 - 140 of this chapter shall engage in guiding activities
11 in any manner, including but not limited to contracting for hunts,
12 employing assistant guides, furnishing camps, and providing equipment
13 and supplies, as appropriate, in a district for which he is not certi-
14 fied. Except as provided in (b) of this section, no guide may be certi-
15 fied for more than one guide district per calendar year. A guide
16 licensed under secs. 100 - 140 of this chapter who wishes to engage in
17 guiding activities in a district other than the one for which he is
18 originally certified, shall apply for certification for the different
19 district in the same manner as he applied originally. Nothing in this
20 section limits a guide licensed under secs. 100 - 140 of this chapter
21 from guiding in more than one district for the purpose of photography
22 only.

23 (b) A guide may be certified for more than one district if he
24 demonstrates clearly to the board that his guiding activity or operation
25 within that district will not adversely affect the guiding activity or
26 business of another guide certified for that district.

27 * Sec. 2. A guide licensed as of the effective date of this Act, who is
28 certified for more than one district, unless he is guiding for the purpose of
29 photography only, shall, within 60 days of the effective date of this Act,

1 choose one district in which he intends to engage in guiding activities
2 initially, and he is subsequently limited, except as provided in AS 08.54.-
3 155(b), to guiding in that district for the remainder of the calendar year
4 in which this Act takes effect. If he wishes to be certified for a different
5 district in a subsequent calendar year, he shall apply for certification for
6 the different district in the same manner as he applied originally. The
7 certification of a licensed guide who fails to make his selection within the
8 specified time terminates without refund of the initial fee.

9 * Sec. 3. A guide licensed as of the effective date of this Act, who has
10 entered into a contract before the effective date of this Act for the purpose
11 of guiding a client in a district other than the one in which he intends to
12 engage in guiding activities initially, as required by this Act, shall pre-
13 sent to the department proof of the contract. Upon submission of satisfactory
14 proof of a prior contract, the department shall issue an extension to the
15 guide to permit performance of that contract only.
