6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to identification cards."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 18.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 ARTICLE 2. IDENTIFICATION CARDS.

10 Sec. 18.65.130. IDENTIFICATION CARDS. (a) Upon payment of a
11 \$5 fee, the Department of Public Safety shall issue a card identical
12 to the motor vehicle operator's license provided for in AS 28.15.080,
13 except that the card shall be of a different color and shall state in
14 bold type letters across the face of it that it is for identification
15 purposes only.

16 (b) A person may obtain an identification card provided for in
17 (a) of this section by applying to the department on forms and in the
18 manner prescribed by the department.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 04.15.063 is repealed.

20 * Sec. 3. AS 04.15.065 is amended to read:

21 Sec. 04.15.065. DRIVER'S LICENSE AS PROOF OF AGE. A valid Alaska
22 driver's license or an [A LIQUOR] identification card issued under
23 AS 18.65.130(a) [SEC. 63 OF THIS CHAPTER] is acceptable as proof of
24 age when used for identification in the purchase of liquor and for
25 presence in establishments where liquor is sold if the license or iden-
26 tification card is made of or encased in plastic and contains a
27 photograph of the license holder and a statement of his age or date
28 of birth. The liquor licensee may not be held liable for any of the
29 penalties imposed for serving minors or permitting minors on the

1 premises when such a driver's license or identification card indicates
2 that the owner and possessor of the license is 19 years of age or
3 over.
