6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of retired physi-  
7 cians; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.64 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 08.64.314. RETIRED LICENSE. A licensee residing in the  
11 state who retires from the active practice of medicine may renew his  
12 license as retired. A retired license permits him to practice in an  
13 emergency. If he returns to the active practice of medicine, he may  
14 not hold a retired license.

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.64.315 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

16 (9) license renewal, biennial, retired ..... 25

17 \* Sec. 3. This Act is retroactive to January 1, 1973 and is applicable  
18 to the renewal of licenses for the 1973-1974 biennium. The Department of  
19 Commerce, division of occupational licensing, shall survey the physicians in  
20 the state holding a license to engage in the active practice of medicine to  
21 determine if any wish to qualify for a retired license during the current  
22 biennium. Upon proper application and surrender of his active license, a  
23 holder of a current license to engage in the active practice of medicine may  
24 receive a retired license and a refund of \$75 for the 1973-1974 biennium.
