6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the compensation of the heads of  
7 the principal executive departments of the state; and  
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 39.20.080(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) The monthly [ANNUAL] salary of the head of each principal  
12 executive department of the state upon appointment and confirmation is  
13 14 per cent higher than the highest monthly salary authorized in the  
14 basic salary schedule (AS 39.27.010) without pay step differentials  
15 and without longevity increments [\$33,000. THE SALARY SHALL BE PAID  
16 IN EQUAL MONTHLY INSTALLMENTS].

17 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 16, 1973.
