6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to political activities of state  
7 employees; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 39.25.160(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 (a) An employee in the classified service may be a member of a  
11 national, state, or local committee of a political party, and may take  
12 part in the management of a political party or in a political campaign,  
13 and may exercise his right as a citizen to express his opinion, register  
14 his party preference, if any, serve as a delegate to party conventions,  
15 and cast his vote. This section also permits appointment, nomination,  
16 or election to nonpartisan public office in a local government unit.

17 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
18 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
