6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to political activities of state  
7 employees; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 39.25.160(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 (a) An employee in the classified service or in those exempt  
11 positions named in sec. 110(3) of this chapter may be a member of a  
12 national, state, or local political party, may take part in a political  
13 campaign, and may exercise his right as a citizen to express his  
14 opinion, register his party preference, if any, serve as a delegate  
15 to party conventions, and cast his vote. This section also permits  
16 appointment, nomination, or election to nonpartisan public office in  
17 a local government unit. However, this section may not be construed as  
18 permitting an employee in the classified service or in those exempt  
19 positions named in sec. 110(3) of this chapter to take an active part  
20 in the management of a political party.

21 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
22 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
