6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to shellfish licensing."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 16.05.630 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 16.05.630. SHELLFISH POT LICENSES [LICENSE]. A separate
10 license is required for shellfish pots used in the taking or catching
11 of each of the following shellfish for commercial purposes in the
12 waters of the state: shrimp, king crab, dungeness crab, and tanner
13 crab. For each 100 pots or less the fee is \$50 [\$15] a year for a
14 resident and \$150 [\$45] a year for a nonresident. For each additional
15 100 pots or less the fee is \$50 [\$15] a year for a resident and \$150
16 [\$45] a year for a nonresident. These fees are required for each
17 license specified in this section.
