6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to school board elections."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 29.28.040 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 29.28.040. MAJORITY ELECTIONS. If in a municipal election
10 no candidate receives in excess of 40 per cent of the votes cast for
11 his respective office, the assembly or council shall hold a runoff
12 election within two weeks from the date of certification of the election
13 between the two candidates receiving the greatest number of votes for
14 the office. Notice of a runoff election shall be published at least
15 five days before the election. The assembly or council may by ordi-
16 nance require a majority vote for election of officials. A runoff
17 election or other means of obtaining a majority may be used. This
18 section does not apply to the election of members of a city or borough
19 school board.
