6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to benefits paid under the federal
7 Social Security Act; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 47.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 47.25.515. EXEMPTION OF FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFIT
12 INCREASES. Notwithstanding the provisions of secs. 430 - 610 of this
13 chapter, if the applicable provisions of the federal Social Security Act,
14 as amended, permit:

15 (1) In determining the need of an applicant for, or a
16 recipient of, old age assistance under secs. 430 - 610 of this chapter
17 who is also receiving Old-Age, Survivors and Disability Insurance benefits under
18 Title II of the federal Social Security Act, any increases in benefits
19 under that title by operation of law after April 1, 1973, shall be dis-
20 regarded.

21 (2) Whenever Old-Age, Survivors and Disability Insurance
22 benefits under Title II of the federal Social Security Act are increased
23 by operation of law after April 1, 1973, old age assistance grants under
24 secs. 430 - 610 of this chapter to persons who are not receiving Old-Age,
25 Survivors and Disability Insurance benefits under Title II of the fed-
26 eral Social Security Act shall be increased by a comparable amount.

27 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
28 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
