6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the composition of municipal boards  
7 of equalization."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 29.53.135 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 29.53.135. BOARD OF EQUALIZATION. (a) The assembly sits as  
11 a board of equalization for the purpose of hearing any appeal from  
12 determinations of the borough assessor, or it may delegate this authority  
13 to a board appointed by it for that purpose. The board of equalization  
14 shall consist of at least that number of members of the assembly over  
15 and above the number required for a quorum to transact business. A  
16 majority of the board shall be composed of members of the assembly.  
17 The board is governed in its proceedings by such procedures consistent  
18 with general rules of administrative law and the laws governing equali-  
19 zation proceedings as may be adopted by ordinance, including but not  
20 limited to quorum and voting requirements. The assembly shall by ordi-  
21 nance adopt rules for the membership and conduct of the board.

22 (b) A quorum of the board may conduct business only if a majority  
23 of the quorum is composed of members of the assembly.
