5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to hairdressing and cosmetology."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 08.28.040 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

9 (5) except as provided in sec. 280 of this chapter, may
10 conduct routine inspections of schools and shops and enforce the provi-
11 sions of this chapter or regulations promulgated under it by the board.

12 * Sec. 2. AS 08.28 is amended by adding a new section to read:

13 Sec. 08.28.045. INVESTIGATIONS. (a) The board may, on its own
14 motion, and shall, upon receipt of a written complaint, investigate
15 a person, school or shop licensed under this chapter.

16 (b) After investigation, the board may dismiss the complaint,
17 warn or reprimand a licensee, or limit or condition a license based
18 on the conclusions it reaches from determination of the facts.

19 * Sec. 3. AS 08.28.100 is amended to read:

20 Sec. 08.28.100. LICENSE REQUIRED. No person may engage in the
21 practice of hairdressing or beauty culture or organize, open, or con-
22 duct a school or shop of hairdressing and beauty culture without a
23 license.

24 * Sec. 4. AS 08.28.170(1) is amended to read:

25 (1) schools: registration and initial license fee. \$500 [\$300]
26 biennial renewal 300 [200]

27 * Sec. 5. AS 08.28.170(11) is amended to read:

28 (11) examination fee 15 [10]

29 * Sec. 6. AS 08.28 is amended by adding a new section to read:

1 Sec. 08.28.275. ADVERTISING. No person, shop or school engaged
2 in the practice of hairdressing or beauty culture may advertise by
3 knowingly employing false or deceptive statements. A hairdressing or
4 beauty culture school employing the terms "accredited" or "approved"
5 or other terms of like connotation in its advertising shall indicate
6 the organization or agency which issued the accreditation or approval.

8 (6) "operator" is a person who engages in any practice
9 defined in (10) [(1)] of this section;

10 * Sec. 8. AS 08.28.320 is amended by adding new paragraphs to read:

11 (14) "board" means the Board of Hairdressing and Beauty
12 Culture Examiners;

13 (15) "department" means the Department of Commerce.
