6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the authorization of funds for
7 trails and footpaths."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 41.20.365(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) An amount of not less than one-quarter of one per cent nor
11 more than [UP TO] one per cent of the total yearly state and federal
12 matching sum combined, under the federal-aid highways program (23 U.S.C.,
13 secs. 101 - 511), shall [MAY] be appropriated annually from the general
14 fund to the Department of Natural Resources for the purposes of pro-
15 viding grants to eligible cities and boroughs for trails and footpaths
16 in appropriate areas, including but not limited to existing park and
17 recreation areas and for the purpose of providing grants to the Depart-
18 ment of Highways for developing the program specified in sec. 355(b)
19 and sec. 360 of this chapter.
