6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to architecture, engineering and land
7 surveying; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Act is to safeguard life,
10 health and property, and to promote the public welfare.

11 * Sec. 2. AS 08.48.261 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 08.48.261. STATE EMPLOYEES. The head of each principal
13 department in which there are positions necessitating use of architec-
14 tural, engineering, or land surveying knowledge or skills shall specify,
15 in the job descriptions, the positions for which registration under
16 this chapter is required. This requirement for any position in a
17 department may be waived by the head of the department, unless the
18 public health or safety is involved. When the requirement is waived,
19 the head of the department shall transmit to the division of personnel
20 a written statement to the effect that the person filling the position
21 is qualified to perform the duties of that position and a statement of
22 the reasons for waiving the requirement, explaining why the employee
23 was hired or was retained as an employee even though not registered
24 under this chapter. The head of the department shall send a copy of
25 the statement to the board.

26 * Sec. 3. AS 08.48.331(4) is amended to read:

27 (4) an officer or employee of the state practicing archi-
28 tecture, engineering or land surveying as required by his official
29 capacity and registration is not required in his job description,

1 unless the public health or safety is involved;

2 * Sec. 4. AS 08.48.331(12) is amended to read:

3 (12) an officer or employee of an individual, firm, partner-
4 ship, association or corporation which officer or employee practices
5 architecture, engineering or land surveying when required by his
6 official capacity or work duties connected with his employment if the
7 individual firm, partnership, association or corporation is not engaged
8 in the business of offering architectural, engineering or land survey-
9 ing services to the public, unless the public health or safety is
10 involved.

11 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect July 1, 1973.
