6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to death benefits under workmen's
7 compensation; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.30.215(a)(2) is amended to read:

10 (2) if there is a surviving wife or dependent husband, to the
11 surviving wife or dependent husband 35 per cent of the average weekly
12 wages of the deceased, during widowhood, or widowerhood with \$10,000 in
13 one sum upon remarriage [, BUT TOTAL COMPENSATION NOT TO EXCEED \$20,000
14 IN THE AGGREGATE];

15 * Sec. 2. AS 23.30.215(a)(4) is amended to read:

16 (4) if there is no surviving wife or dependent husband or
17 child or children, then for the support of father, mother, grandchildren,
18 brothers and sisters, if dependent upon the deceased at the time of
19 injury, 35 per cent of the average weekly wage of the deceased to such
20 beneficiaries, share and share alike [, NOT TO EXCEED \$20,000 IN THE
21 AGGREGATE].

22 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
23 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
