6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to limitations on the issuance of new  
7 liquor licenses; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 04.10.210 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (3) under (1) and (2) of this section, unless the governing  
11 body of the municipality or political subdivision recommends through  
12 ordinance that additional licenses be issued for reasons of public  
13 convenience or necessity, in which case the board shall either issue  
14 the new license or, upon protest from the governing body, conduct  
15 hearings as provided for under sec. 270 of this chapter before making  
16 its final determination. If 40 percent of the residents of the  
17 municipality petition the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to reject  
18 the application for a license under this section, the board shall  
19 reject the license application.

20 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
21 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
