6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to interference with commercial
7 fishing gear."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 16.10.055. INTERFERENCE WITH COMMERCIAL FISHING GEAR. A
11 person who wilfully or with reckless disregard of the consequences of
12 his activity, interferes with or damages the commercial fishing gear
13 of another person, upon conviction, is guilty of a misdemeanor. For
14 the purposes of this section "interference" means the physical distur-
15 bance of gear which results in economic loss or loss of fishing time,
16 and "reckless disregard of the consequences" means a lack of considera-
17 tion for the consequences of one's acts in a manner that is reasonably
18 likely to damage the property of another.
