6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to licensure to practice chiropractic;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.20.120(5) and (7) are repealed.

10 * Sec. 2. AS 08.20.120 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

11 (8) passes an examination identical to that required for
12 licensure to practice medicine or osteopathy in the state under
13 AS 08.64.210 and 08.64.220; however, the provisions of AS 08.64.250
14 (licensure by endorsement) do not apply to applicants for licensure
15 to practice chiropractic.

16 * Sec. 3. AS 08.20.130 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

17 Sec. 08.20.130. EXAMINATIONS. (a) Examinations for a license to
18 practice chiropractic shall be held at the time and in the manner fixed
19 by the State Medical Board under ch. 64 of this title.

20 (b) The examination shall be identical to that prescribed for
21 licensure to practice medicine or osteopathy in the state under
22 AS 08.64.210 and 08.64.220; however, the provisions of AS 08.64.250
23 (licensure by endorsement) do not apply to applicants for licensure to
24 practice chiropractic.

25 (c) The passing grade on the examination shall be the same as
26 that for passing the examination for licensure to practice medicine or
27 osteopathy in the state under AS 08.64.210 and 08.64.220.

28 (d) An applicant may take a re-examination under the same terms
29 and conditions as an applicant for licensure to practice medicine or

1 osteopathy under AS 08.64.260.

2 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1973.
