6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to per diem allowances for officials  
7 and employees of the state; and providing for an  
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 39.20.110 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 39.20.110. PER DIEM ALLOWANCE. Officials and employees of  
12 the state agencies, while traveling on official business and away from  
13 their designated post of duty, shall be allowed, instead of their actual  
14 expenses for subsistence and all fees or tips, a per diem allowance to  
15 be prescribed by the commissioner of administration under the regulatory  
16 authority set out in sec. 160 of this chapter, and in consultation with  
17 the head of the agency concerned, not to exceed the rate of \$35 [\$30]  
18 for each day or part of a day of travel inside or outside the state.

19 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
20 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
