5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the issuance of general obliga-  
7 tion bonds in the amount of \$8,700,000 for the purpose  
8 of paying the cost of Department of Health and Social  
9 Services facilities; and providing for an effective  
10 date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 \* Section 1. For the purpose of paying the cost of Department of Health  
13 and Social Services facilities construction, general obligation bonds of  
14 the state in the principal amount of not more than \$8,700,000 shall be  
15 issued and sold. The full faith, credit and resources of the state are  
16 pledged to the payment of the principal of and interest and redemption  
17 premium, if any, on these bonds. These bonds shall be issued under the  
18 provisions of AS 37.15 as those provisions read at the time of issuance.

19 \* Sec. 2. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified  
20 voters of the state, a special fund of the state to be known as the "1974  
21 Health and Social Services Facilities Construction Fund" shall be estab-  
22 lished, to which shall be credited the proceeds of the sale of the bonds  
23 described in sec. 1 of this Act except for the accrued interest and premiums.  
24 There is appropriated from the "1974 Health and Social Services Facilities  
25 Construction Fund" to the Department of Health and Social Services the amount  
26 of \$8,700,000. The specific uses of the proceeds of these bonds shall be  
27 determined by the governor in accord with the following statement of the  
28 scope of the major projects as required by AS 24.30.037:

29 (1) Palmer - health center

- 1 (2) Fairbanks - health center
- 2 (3) Anchorage - Alaska Psychiatric Institute
- 3 (4) purchase City of Valdez interest in Harborview
- 4 (5) Harborview - paving and carpeting
- 5 (6) Alcantra - living quarters construction
- 6 (7) Ketchikan - adult correctional facility
- 7 (8) Juneau - multi-purpose auditorium
- 8 (9) Juneau - juvenile detention unit
- 9 (10) Fairbanks - juvenile detention unit

10 \* Sec. 3. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the quali-  
11 fied voters of the state, the amount of \$30,450 or as much of that amount  
12 as is found necessary is appropriated from the general fund of the state  
13 to the state bond committee to carry out the provisions of this Act  
14 and to pay expenses incident to the sale and issuance of the bonds author-  
15 ized in this Act. The amounts expended from the appropriation authorized  
16 by this section shall be reimbursed to the general fund from the proceeds  
17 of the sale of the bonds authorized by this Act.

18 \* Sec. 4. The question whether the bonds authorized in this Act are  
19 to be issued shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the state at  
20 the next state general election and shall read substantially as follows:

22 State General Obligation Department of Health  
23 and Social Services Facilities Construction

24 Bonds \$8,700,000

25 Shall the State of Alaska issue its general obligation bonds  
26 in the principal amount of not more than \$8,700,000 for the  
27 purpose of paying the cost of Department of Health and Social  
28 Services facilities construction?
